In 1969 a group of determined people decided to convert what had been a stable block into a Church Hall.

The outside built in stone was in good condition, but the inside even though it had been used as a storage area was considered suitable for renovation.

With the help of many willing hands efforts were made to raise funds. Many kind people offered small loans together with a marvellous flower festival, which meant that by 1976 the hall as it is today was completed. A time of great rejoicing.

The hall is now used for many activities and between the months of May and September is open to serve tea and coffee to the many visitors to the church. All the money raised going towards the up keep of the church.
